Summary (as of Oct 16, 2017)

Seniors' Security Act of 2017

This bill requires the use of a Consumer Price Index for Elderly Consumers (CPI-E) to calculate certain cost-of-living adjustments with respect to the Old Age, Survivors, and Disability Insurance benefits program and certain other federal retirement benefits. The Department of Labor must prepare and publish the CPI-E for each calendar month.

The bill also limits certain increases in Medicare premiums.

Actions Timeline

- **Nov 16, 2017:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Military Personnel.
- **Oct 20, 2017:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Oct 16, 2017:** Introduced in House
- **Oct 16, 2017:** Referred to the Committee on Ways and Means, and in addition to the Committees on Education and the Workforce, Energy and Commerce, Armed Services, and Oversight and Government Reform, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
