### Summary (as of Oct 24, 2017)

#### Danny's Law

This bill requires the President to establish a commission called the "Anti-Bullying Roundtable" to study bullying in elementary and secondary schools in the United States.

The roundtable must submit a report about best practices concerning bullying, including recommendations for:

(1) combating bullying, (2) educating school officials to recognize bullying, and (3) helping parents to address the early warning signs of bullying with their children.

- **Oct 24, 2017:** Referred to the House Committee on Education and the Workforce.
