### Summary (as of Jan 10, 2017)

#### Enlisted Legal Assistance Act

This bill requires the Secretary of the military department concerned to provide personal civil legal assistance to:

- an active duty member of the Armed Forces in pay grades E-1 through E-5 and his or her dependents; and
- a survivor who was a dependent of the member at the time of the member's death, except that survivor eligibility shall be determined pursuant to regulations prescribed by the Secretary concerned.
