Summary (as of Oct 25, 2017)

Health Care Choice and Affordability Act

This bill allows a state to offer a Medicaid buy-in option for qualifying individuals on health insurance exchanges, if the state has at least one political subdivision in which fewer than two health insurers participate in such exchanges.

Actions Timeline

- **Oct 27, 2017:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Oct 25, 2017:** Introduced in House
- **Oct 25, 2017:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committee on Ways and Means, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
