Summary (as of Nov 1, 2017)

Medicare Care Coordination Improvement Act of 2017

This bill exempts certain alternative payment models under Medicare from the general prohibition on physician self-referrals (also known as the Stark law).

Actions Timeline

- Nov 3, 2017: Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- Nov 1, 2017: Introduced in House
- Nov 1, 2017: Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committee on Ways and Means, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
