Summary (as of Nov 7, 2017)

Nicholas and Zachary Burt Memorial Carbon Monoxide Poisoning Prevention Act of 2017

This bill directs the Consumer Product Safety Commission to establish a grant program to provide assistance to states for specified activities related to the prevention of carbon monoxide poisoning, including installation of alarms in certain dwellings and facilities.

Actions Timeline

- **Nov 10, 2017:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Digital Commerce and Consumer Protection.
- **Nov 7, 2017:** Introduced in House
- **Nov 7, 2017:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committee on House Administration, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
