115 SRES 247	Related bill	Aug 3, 2017: Submitted in the Senate, considered, and agreed to without amendment and with a preamble by Unanimous Consent. (consideration: CR S4882, S4894; text: CR S4882)

Express support for: (1) the designation of Paralympic and Adaptive Sport Day, and (2) the inclusive goals of the Paralympic Movement.

Recognizes: (1) the value of sport for athletes with a disability, and (2) the contribution and sacrifice of members of the Armed Forces who have sustained a traumatic injury and acquired a disability in the service of the United States.

Promotes a more inclusive society for all people with a disability through paralympic and adaptive sport.

Actions Timeline

- **Jul 26, 2017:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Military Personnel.
- **Jul 11, 2017:** Introduced in House
- **Jul 11, 2017:** Referred to the Committee on Foreign Affairs, and in addition to the Committees on Armed Services, and Veterans' Affairs, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
