Summary (as of Dec 14, 2017)

Curbing Realistic Exploitative Electronic Pedophilic Robots Act of 2017 or the CREEPER Act of 2017

This bill amends the federal criminal code to broaden the prohibition on importation or transportation of obscene materials.

Specifically, the bill makes it a crime to import, or knowingly use a common carrier or interactive computer service to transport in interstate or foreign commerce, a child sex doll.

Actions Timeline

- **Jun 14, 2018:** Received in the Senate and Read twice and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary.
- **Jun 13, 2018:** Mr. Goodlatte moved to suspend the rules and pass the bill.
- **Jun 13, 2018:** Considered under suspension of the rules. (consideration: CR H5119-5121)
- **Jun 13, 2018:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with forty minutes of debate on H.R. 4655.
- **Jun 13, 2018:** Passed/agreed to in House: On motion to suspend the rules and pass the bill Agreed to by voice vote.(text: CR H5119-5120)
- **Jun 13, 2018:** On motion to suspend the rules and pass the bill Agreed to by voice vote. (text: CR H5119-5120)
- **Jun 13, 2018:** Motion to reconsider laid on the table Agreed to without objection.
- **Jan 22, 2018:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Crime, Terrorism, Homeland Security, and Investigations.
