Summary (as of Dec 21, 2017)

Medicare IVIG Access Enhancement Act

This bill requires the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services to establish a three-year demonstration project to evaluate the benefits of providing Medicare coverage and payment for items and services needed for the in-home administration of intravenous immune globulin to treat chronic inflammatory demyelinating polyneuropathy or multifocal motor neuropathy. Beneficiary participation shall be voluntary.

Actions Timeline

- **Dec 22, 2017:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Dec 21, 2017:** Introduced in House
- **Dec 21, 2017:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committee on Ways and Means, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
