Summary (as of Jan 16, 2018)

Communications Facilities Deployment on Federal Property Act of 2018

This bill amends the Middle Class Tax Relief and Job Creation Act of 2012 to require the General Services Administration (GSA) to create a common form and to establish a common processing fee for applications for easements, rights-of-way, and leases relating to communications facility installations on federal property.

The GSA must develop a master contract for the placement of communications facility installations on federal property.

Actions Timeline

- **Jan 19, 2018:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Communications and Technology.
- **Jan 17, 2018:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Economic Development, Public Buildings and Emergency Management.
- **Jan 16, 2018:** Introduced in House
- **Jan 16, 2018:** Referred to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure, and in addition to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
