Summary (as of Oct 1, 2018)

Calls for the international community to demand that North Korea dismantle its labor camp system and for North Korea to cease human rights abuses, release political prisoners, and condemn the use of forced labor.

Calls on the U.S. government to pursue additional sanctions against those individuals responsible for the North Korean labor camp system.

- **Oct 1, 2018:** Placed on Senate Legislative Calendar under General Orders. Calendar No. 609.

- **Apr 24, 2018:** Introduced in Senate
- **Apr 24, 2018:** Referred to the Committee on Foreign Relations. (text of measure as introduced: CR S2393-2394)
