Summary (as of Jan 19, 2018)

Connecting Communities Post Disasters Act of 2018

This bill requires the Federal Communications Commission to exempt projects that replace or make improvements to communications facilities following a major disaster or presidentially declared emergency from any requirement to prepare an environmental assessment or environmental impact statement under the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969. Such projects are also exempt from considerations about the effect they will have on any historic property.

Actions Timeline

- **Jan 26, 2018:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Communications and Technology.
- **Jan 23, 2018:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Federal Lands.
- **Jan 19, 2018:** Introduced in House
- **Jan 19, 2018:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committee on Natural Resources, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
