Stop Online Opioid Sales Act of 2018

This bill requires the Drug Enforcement Administration to publish annually on its website a report on the Internet sale of controlled substances and controlled substance analogues.

Actions Timeline

- **Mar 8, 2018:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Crime, Terrorism, Homeland Security, and Investigations.
- **Feb 16, 2018:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Feb 14, 2018:** Introduced in House
- **Feb 14, 2018:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committee on the Judiciary, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
