Challenges & Prizes for Climate Act of 2018

This bill requires the Department of Energy to establish a Climate Solutions Challenges program for carrying out competitions that award cash and other incentives for climate and energy solutions, such as:

- capturing carbon and converting the carbon into a beneficial use,
- achieving transformative increases in energy efficiency,
- achieving implementation or grid integration of advanced energy storage technology,
- providing approaches to mitigating or adapting to the effects of climate change, and
- providing data analytics on the climate and related phenomena.

Actions Timeline

- **May 22, 2018:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Research and Technology.
- **Feb 15, 2018:** Introduced in House
- **Feb 15, 2018:** Referred to the House Committee on Science, Space, and Technology.
