Restoring Integrity in our Elected Officials Act

This bill generally prohibits federal lobbying by, and federal contracts with, former elected officials and certain employees or family members of former elected officials.

Actions Timeline

- **Apr 30, 2018:** Referred to the Subcommittee on the Constitution and Civil Justice.
- **Mar 14, 2018:** Introduced in House
- **Mar 14, 2018:** Referred to the Committee on the Judiciary, and in addition to the Committee on Oversight and Government Reform, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
