Summary (as of Mar 19, 2018)

Iran Human Rights Accountability Act of 2018

This bill amends the Comprehensive Iran Sanctions, Accountability, and Divestment Act of 2010 with respect to the list of sanctionable Iranian government officials or persons acting on behalf of such government who are responsible for or complicit in certain human rights abuses to include as sanctionable activities human rights abuses committed against U.S. citizens or legal permanent resident aliens.

Actions Timeline

- **Mar 29, 2018:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Trade.
- **Mar 19, 2018:** Introduced in House
- **Mar 19, 2018:** Referred to the Committee on Foreign Affairs, and in addition to the Committees on the Judiciary, Ways and Means, and Financial Services, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
