FDR Historic Preservation Act

This bill authorizes the Department of the Interior to acquire, by donation, purchase from a willing seller, or exchange, approximately 89 acres of land to be added to the Home of Franklin D. Roosevelt National Historic Site.

- **Sep 26, 2018:** Motion to reconsider laid on the table Agreed to without objection.
