Fair Debt Collections Practices Clarification Act of 2018

This bill amends the Fair Debt Collection Practices Act to provide that, in an action brought under that Act, costs may be awarded to a defendant only if the action was brought in bad faith.

Actions Timeline

- **May 21, 2018:** Referred to the Subcommittee on the Constitution and Civil Justice.
- **Apr 12, 2018:** Introduced in House
- **Apr 12, 2018:** Referred to the Committee on Financial Services, and in addition to the Committee on the Judiciary, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
