Summary (as of Apr 12, 2018)

Hope Opportunity and Prosperity for Everyone Act or the Hope Act

This bill (1) limits assistance under the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) program; (2) restricts eligibility for participation in the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP); and (3) otherwise revises provisions related to TANF and SNAP, including with respect to work requirements.

Actions Timeline

- **Apr 30, 2018:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Nutrition.
- **Apr 18, 2018:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Human Resources.
- **Apr 12, 2018:** Introduced in House
- **Apr 12, 2018:** Referred to the Committee on Ways and Means, and in addition to the Committee on Agriculture, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
