School Watch and Tactics Act of 2018

This bill directs the Department of Justice to develop, disseminate, and publish best practices for occupation-specific education for school resource officers.

Actions Timeline

- **May 22, 2018:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Crime, Terrorism, Homeland Security, and Investigations.
- **Apr 16, 2018:** Introduced in House
- **Apr 16, 2018:** Referred to the Committee on Education and the Workforce, and in addition to the Committee on the Judiciary, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
