Summary (as of Apr 17, 2018)

This bill amends the Farm Security and Rural Investment Act of 2002 to repeal the Desert Terminal Lakes Program. (The Department of Agriculture program requires the transfer of certain Commodity Credit Corporation funds to the Bureau of Reclamation to provide water to at-risk natural desert terminal lakes.)

Actions Timeline

- **Apr 30, 2018:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Conservation and Forestry.
- **Apr 20, 2018:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Water, Power and Oceans.
- **Apr 17, 2018:** Introduced in House
- **Apr 17, 2018:** Referred to the Committee on Agriculture, and in addition to the Committee on Natural Resources, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
