Summary (as of Apr 18, 2018)

This bill specifies that certain Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA) programs may award grants, and grantees may make subgrants, to local or regional nonprofit organizations, including faith-based organizations.

The bill also specifies that SAMHSA may renew grants to residential treatment programs for pregnant and postpartum women for up to five years.
