Summary (as of Apr 23, 2018)

Clean Energy Victory Bond Act of 2018

This bill requires the Department of the Treasury to issue Clean Energy Victory Bonds. The proceeds from the sale of the bonds must be deposited into the Clean Energy Victory Bonds Trust Fund and be used to carry activities of the Department of Energy's Office of Energy Efficiency and Renewable Energy.

Actions Timeline

- **May 22, 2018:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Energy.
- **Apr 23, 2018:** Introduced in House
- **Apr 23, 2018:** Referred to the Committee on Ways and Means, and in addition to the Committees on Energy and Commerce, and Science, Space, and Technology, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
