Summary (as of May 8, 2018)

Medicaid Drug Rebate Accountability Act

This bill requires drug manufacturers with Medicaid rebate agreements for covered outpatient drugs to correct any misclassifications of such drugs within a specified time period, and establishes civil penalties for failures to do so.
