Summary (as of Oct 23, 2017)

Reaffirms U.S. support for the government of Georgia, its people, and its membership in NATO.

Honors the sacrifices of Georgian servicemembers and their families in the cause of freedom.

Supports Georgia's commitment to: (1) a peaceful resolution to the dispute with Russia; and (2) institutional reforms, freedom, territorial independence, and integration into Euro-Atlantic institutions.

Calls for the end of Russia's occupation of Georgian sovereign territory.

Supports increased economic cooperation and bilateral trade between the United States and Georgia.

Calls for the Georgian government to: (1) strengthen and enforce the rule of law with regard to adhering to contractual obligations and protecting intellectual property rights, and (2) demonstrate its commitment to welcome and respect freely negotiated conditions of business investment.

Stands by Georgia and its people and the shared vision of a free and independent Georgia.

Actions Timeline

- **Nov 29, 2017:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Europe, Eurasia, and Emerging Threats.
- **Oct 23, 2017:** Introduced in House
- **Oct 23, 2017:** Referred to the Committee on Foreign Affairs, and in addition to the Committee on Ways and Means, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
