Trade Authority Protection Act

This bill amends the Trade Act of 1974 to allow Congress to object to certain trade actions.

Actions Timeline

- **May 29, 2018:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Trade.
- **May 10, 2018:** Introduced in House
- **May 10, 2018:** Referred to the Committee on Ways and Means, and in addition to the Committee on Rules, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
