Summary (as of May 11, 2018)

Promoting Quality of Care in Pain Management Act of 2018

This bill requires the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services to convene a technical expert panel to recommend opioid and opioid-use disorder quality measures for possible use in hospital payment and reporting models under Medicare.

Actions Timeline

- **May 31, 2018:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **May 11, 2018:** Introduced in House
- **May 11, 2018:** Referred to the Committee on Ways and Means, and in addition to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
