Securing the International Mail Against Opioids Act of 2018

This bill establishes requirements related to U.S. Postal Service (USPS) international mail shipments. Among other requirements, the bill requires USPS to gather advanced data on its shipments and share such information with U.S. Customs and Border Protection and assesses a fee on overseas inbound express mail.

- **Jun 14, 2018:** Rule provides for consideration of H.R. 2851, H.R. 5735 and H.R. 5788 with 1 hour of general debate. Previous question shall be considered as ordered without intervening motions except motion to recommit with or without instructions. Measure will be considered read. Specified amendments are in order.
- **Jun 14, 2018:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with one hour of debate on H.R. 5788.
- **Jun 14, 2018:** The previous question was ordered pursuant to the rule.
