Summary (as of May 16, 2018)

Protecting Family Resources and Training Options Act

This bill (1) applies to state Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) programs specified provisions of federal law regarding improper payment, and (2) eliminates the 12-month limit on counting vocational training as work activities for purposes of meeting mandatory work requirements under the TANF program.

Actions Timeline

- **Jun 4, 2018:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Human Resources.
- **May 16, 2018:** Introduced in House
- **May 16, 2018:** Referred to the Committee on Ways and Means, and in addition to the Committee on Education and the Workforce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
