Summary (as of Oct 24, 2017)

Congressional Cybersecurity Training Resolution of 2017

Amends Rule II (Other Officers and Officials) of the Rules of the House of Representatives to require: (1) the Chief Administrative Officer (CAO) to carry out an annual information security training program for Members, officers, and employees of the House; and (2) new Members, officers, and employees to receive such training within 30 days after beginning service.

Requires each officer and employee of the House to file with the CAO by January 31 of each year a certification that he or she completed such program.
