Improving Access to Good Jobs for Parents Act

This bill establishes, and provides funds for, grants to support the coordination of specified job-related activities through the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) program.

Actions Timeline

- **Jun 4, 2018:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Human Resources.
- **May 21, 2018:** Introduced in House
- **May 21, 2018:** Referred to the Committee on Ways and Means, and in addition to the Committee on Education and the Workforce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
