Substance Abuse Prevention Act of 2018

This bill reauthorizes through FY2022 various health and law enforcement programs related to the prevention and treatment of substance abuse and the reduction of demand for illicit drugs.

The bill reauthorizes, among others, the following:

- the Office of National Drug Control Policy,
- the Drug-Free Communities Program,
- the High Intensity Drug Trafficking Areas Program, and
- the Drug Courts Program.

Actions Timeline

- **Jul 24, 2018:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Crime, Terrorism, Homeland Security, and Investigations.
- **May 23, 2018:** Introduced in House
- **May 23, 2018:** Referred to the Committee on Oversight and Government Reform, and in addition to the Committees on the Judiciary, and Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
