### Summary (as of May 23, 2018)

#### Veterans Crisis Response Corps Act of 2018

This bill establishes the Veterans Crisis Response Corps under which veterans may elect to participate as Corps members in disaster relief and reconstruction projects following a domestic or international man-made or natural disaster.

- **May 23, 2018:** Referred to the Committee on Veterans' Affairs, and in addition to the Committees on Transportation and Infrastructure, Foreign Affairs, and Armed Services, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
- **May 23, 2018:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Economic Opportunity.
