Donald Payne Sr. Colorectal Cancer Detection Act of 2018

This bill provides for Medicare coverage and payment, subject to specified frequency limits, of certain colorectal cancer screening blood-based tests.

Actions Timeline

- **Jun 14, 2018:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Jun 8, 2018:** Introduced in House
- **Jun 8, 2018:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committee on Ways and Means, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
