Summary (as of Jun 14, 2018)

VA Personnel Equity Act of 2018

This bill repeals certain provisions with respect to procedures for the removal, demotion, or suspension of employees of the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) based on performance or misconduct. The Government Accountability Office shall report on the proposed and final disciplines and removals of certain VA employees.

Actions Timeline

- **Jun 14, 2018:** Introduced in House
- **Jun 14, 2018:** Referred to the Committee on Veterans' Affairs, and in addition to the Committee on Oversight and Government Reform, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
- **Jun 14, 2018:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Economic Opportunity.
