Generating American Income and Infrastructure Now Act

This bill requires the Department of Agriculture (USDA) to sell certain distressed notes and other obligations held by USDA. The sale must be conducted under terms and procedures established by the Department of the Treasury and specified in the bill. Of the proceeds from the sale: (1) 50% must be deposited into an account for carrying out infrastructure projects in low-income communities, and (2) 50% must be retained in the Treasury for deficit reduction.

Actions Timeline

- **Jun 15, 2018:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Economic Development, Public Buildings and Emergency Management.
- **Jun 14, 2018:** Introduced in House
- **Jun 14, 2018:** Referred to the Committee on Agriculture, and in addition to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
