Summary (as of Jun 19, 2018)

This bill directs the Department of Energy to report to Congress on a potential pilot program for the construction and operation of at least one micromuclear reactor (i.e., a reactor that has the thermal-power production capacity of up to 50 megawatts) to provide energy resilience for critical security infrastructure.
