Summary (as of Jun 20, 2018)

Solar Vocational Education and Training for our Servicemembers Act or the Solar VETS Act

This bill requires the Department of Energy (DOE), in collaboration with the Department of Defense, to develop a training course for careers in solar-related occupations to be (1) made available at military installations and to eligible members of the Armed Forces, and (2) administered by institutions of higher education pursuant to an agreement with DOE.

Actions Timeline

- **Oct 19, 2018:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Higher Education and Workforce Development.
- **Jun 21, 2018:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Military Personnel.
- **Jun 20, 2018:** Introduced in House
- **Jun 20, 2018:** Referred to the Committee on Education and the Workforce, and in addition to the Committee on Armed Services, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
