This bill establishes requirements for various federal agencies regarding the collection and publication of statistics relating to Puerto Rico.

Actions Timeline

- **Jul 9, 2018:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Indian, Insular and Alaska Native Affairs.
- **Jun 25, 2018:** Introduced in House
- **Jun 25, 2018:** Referred to the Committee on Natural Resources, and in addition to the Committees on Energy and Commerce, Oversight and Government Reform, Education and the Workforce, Agriculture, the Judiciary, and Financial Services, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
