Restoring Fair Housing Protections Eliminated by HUD Act of 2018

This bill requires the Department of Housing and Urban Development to take certain measures to address fair housing, including by (1) developing a public database of complaints of discriminatory housing practices, and (2) implementing or reissuing specified rules related to fair housing.

Actions Timeline

- **Aug 2, 2018:** Referred to the Subcommittee on the Constitution and Civil Justice.
- **Jun 26, 2018:** Introduced in House
- **Jun 26, 2018:** Referred to the Committee on the Judiciary, and in addition to the Committee on Financial Services, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
