Chronic Wasting Disease Transmission in Cervidae Study Act

This bill requires the Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service to study the predominant pathways and mechanisms of the transmission of chronic wasting disease in wild, captive, and farmed populations of deer, elk, reindeer, and moose populations in the United States.

Actions Timeline

- **Aug 16, 2018:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Livestock and Foreign Agriculture.
- **Jul 16, 2018:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Federal Lands.
- **Jun 28, 2018:** Introduced in House
- **Jun 28, 2018:** Referred to the Committee on Agriculture, and in addition to the Committee on Natural Resources, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
