Creating Opportunity and Sustainability Through Science Act or the COASTS Act

This bill directs the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration to award competitive grants to certain entities for (1) activities that strengthen coastal communities, and (2) restoration of coastal habitats to provide vital habitat for fish and strengthen the resilience of coastal ecosystems.

Actions Timeline

- **Jul 12, 2018:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Water, Power and Oceans.
- **Jun 28, 2018:** Introduced in House
- **Jun 28, 2018:** Referred to the Committee on Natural Resources, and in addition to the Committee on Science, Space, and Technology, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
