Merit Systems Protection Board Reauthorization Act of 2018

This bill reauthorizes the Merit Systems Protection Board (MSPB) for FY2019-FY2023. Additionally, the bill modifies the authority of the MSPB and directs it to establish a filing fee for claims.

- **Jul 16, 2018:** Referred to the Committee on Oversight and Government Reform, and in addition to the Committee on Veterans' Affairs, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
- **Jul 16, 2018:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Economic Opportunity.
