Summary (as of Jul 24, 2018)

Seniors Accessing Vouchers Equally Act or the SAVE Act

This bill exempts the use of certain cost-sharing coupons by pharmacies or drug manufacturers under the Medicare prescription drug benefit from specified criminal penalties relating to illegal remunerations, so long as there is no generic version of the drug to which the coupon applies.

Actions Timeline

- **Aug 8, 2018:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Jul 27, 2018:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Jul 24, 2018:** Introduced in House
- **Jul 24, 2018:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committee on Ways and Means, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
