### Summary (as of Jul 24, 2018)

#### Safe LPG Storage Act of 2018

This bill directs the Department of Transportation to establish a program under which it may award grants to covered entities (i.e., state, local, or tribal governments, a special purpose district or public authority, including a port authority, or an owner or operator of a liquified petroleum gas [LPG] storage facility that is located within five miles of a populated area, home, or school) for the relocation of such LPG facilities.

## Actions Timeline

- **Jul 27, 2018:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Energy.
- **Jul 25, 2018:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Railroads, Pipelines, and Hazardous Materials.
- **Jul 24, 2018:** Introduced in House
- **Jul 24, 2018:** Referred to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure, and in addition to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
