### Summary (as of Jul 26, 2018)

#### Recent Grads in Start-Ups and Innovation Act

This bill amends the Higher Education Act of 1965 to allow a no-interest deferment of federal student loans for a recent college graduate who owns a small business that has at least one employee other than the owner and is located in a qualified opportunity zone.
