This bill revises energy performance requirements for federal buildings.

- **Jul 26, 2018:** Introduced in House
- **Jul 26, 2018:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
