Summary (as of Jul 26, 2018)

Medicare Secondary Payer and Workers' Compensation Settlement Agreements Act of 2018

This bill alters provisions relating to Medicare secondary payer rules with respect to workers' compensation settlement arrangements. Among other things, the bill provides that a Medicare set-aside fulfills secondary payer obligations if the set-aside is included in the arrangement and meets certain other criteria.

Actions Timeline

- **Aug 14, 2018:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Jul 27, 2018:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Jul 26, 2018:** Introduced in House
- **Jul 26, 2018:** Referred to the Committee on Ways and Means, and in addition to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
