### Summary (as of Dec 13, 2017)

Recognizes: (1) the dispute between Israel and the Palestinian Authority but expresses the belief that it should be settled internally, (2) the historical aspects of the Israeli-Palestinian Authority relationships but continues to recognize Israel's sovereignty to choose its own capital, and (3) that Israel is the strongest U.S. ally in the Middle East.

Reaffirms the strong relationship between the United States and Israel.

Affirms opposition to recent actions by the United Nations General Assembly approving certain resolutions concerning Israel and the Palestine Liberation Organization.
