Ensuring Scott Pruitt is Accountable Act of 2018 or the EPA Act of 2018

This bill prohibits the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) from finalizing or implementing a rule signed by former Administrator Scott Pruitt until the EPA publishes a report on certain investigations of Scott Pruitt.

Actions Timeline

- Aug 3, 2018: Referred to the Subcommittee on Environment.
- Aug 1, 2018: Referred to the Subcommittee on Water Resources and Environment.
- Jul 31, 2018: Introduced in House
- Jul 31, 2018: Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committees on
 Transportation and Infrastructure, Agriculture, and Science, Space, and Technology, for a period to be subsequently
 determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the
 committee concerned.
